

Plum Creek Foundation Grant Application

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What are the qualifications required for organizations applying for funding?

To apply for Foundation funding, you must be a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization OR a public entity – city, town, school, fire dept., etc. If you are a non-profit organization that does not have 501(c)(3) status from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) AND a determination letter from the IRS indicating this status, you cannot apply for funding. Note: a taxpayer identification number from the IRS is NOT proof of 501(c)(3) status.

Q. When are the applications due?

Applications are accepted throughout the year and are considered on a quarterly basis. Upcoming deadlines are listed below. *Note that applications must be postmarked, not received, by the deadline date.* Overnight packages may be sent on the deadline date.

Q. Can I fill out an application online?

While you cannot submit an application online, we do have the application in a Word document that you can fill out electronically. You may download the application from the Foundation website: http://www.plumcreek.com/community/grant_application.php.

Q. Can I submit my application to you by fax or email?

No. We require that the original, signed application be mailed to us and postmarked on or before the postmark deadline above.

Q. Do I need to limit the information I provide on the application to the size of the boxes under each question?

No. If you fill out the application electronically (via the Word version), you can expand the boxes to whatever size you need. You may also remove the boxes if you wish (but you must still answer the question!).

Q. The application asks for a copy of our IRS 990 form. What if we don't have to file one?

The 990 form is filed by 501(c)(3) organizations which have operating income over \$25,000. If your organization is not required to file a 990 form, just indicate that this item is not applicable to your organization.

Q. Your application states that you consider grants in the areas where you operate. What do you consider your operating area?

Plum Creek operates in the following states:

Please note that the Plum Creek Foundation generally restricts its giving to communities around our land base. Not all communities in the counties listed will be eligible for grants. Q. Will you fund a request for operating support?

We prefer to provide funding for a special project or program and strongly encourage applicants to apply for a specific project or something tangible, like equipment, rather than operating support. We generally do not provide funding for salaries, stipends or other forms of compensation.

Q. Does the Foundation fund United Way chapter agencies?

No. The Plum Creek Foundation does not fund United Way chapter agencies (e.g. United Way of King County, United Way of Flathead County).

Q. Does the Foundation fund organizations supported by United Way chapter agencies?

The Plum Creek Foundation does not fund operating expense requests from United Way-funded organizations. However, the Foundation does consider capital expenditure requests from United Way-funded organizations. Applications from United Way-funded organizations MUST include a letter of support for their project from their United Way chapter.

Q. How many copies of the application do I need to send to Plum Creek?

Please send just one copy of the application and attachments.

Q. May I include additional attachments as part of my application?

Please do not include additional attachments unless they are absolutely essential to our understanding of your request.

Q. When will I be notified of the Foundation's decision regarding my application?

The Foundation Board meets to review grant applications approximately 4-6 weeks after the application deadline date. When we receive your application, we will send you a postcard notifying you that we have received the application. The postcard will indicate the approximate date of the meeting during which your application will be considered. You will receive written notification of the Foundation Board's decision approximately two weeks after the meeting date.
