#### **Scholarships awarded to 12 Maine high school students**

**FAIRFIELD, Maine** – Plum Creek today announced it has awarded a scholarship to Brittany York of Strong. York is among 12 Maine high school students to receive a scholarship from the company. Plum Creek annually awards scholarships to high school seniors who plan to continue their education after high school graduation. Students are selected based on their academic achievements, participation in extracurricular activities and career goals.
