Plum Creek Awards \$5,000 to Superior Area Ambulance Service

MISSOULA, Mont. – The Plum Creek Foundation recently awarded a \$5,000 grant to the Superior Area Ambulance Service, which will be used to construct a new emergency services facility.

The Superior Area Ambulance Service purchased land across from the Mineral Community Hospital to build a new ambulance service facility. The new facility will help meet the community's growing need for emergency services. It will have a garage with room for three ambulances, office space, two handicap-accessible restrooms, a full service kitchen, storage room and a training area. The new facility will also allow the organization to safely store its medical equipment and supplies.
